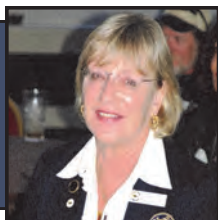
**Teresa Russell** provided outstanding musical entertainment .

As the year marches on, the days are getting shorter and our on-the-water activities are fewer. However, **Sunday, October 7**, was a **triple event** – **Curt and Mary Ingram** hosted our **first Electric Boat Poker Run**, which started and ended at the club, where **Gary and Joyce Johnson** hosted a **dinghy party** and **Jerry Wood** hosted an **Open House**. **Great food by Gary and team**, plus live music by **Theresa Russell**, topped off the day.

Several CIYC racers competed in ASBCYC/SCYA races in October, including **Bob Heatherly (GRACE)**. Most of Bob's new crew members are transplants from the **Krum Crew**, as Harry has recently taken a job in San Diego. Meanwhile, Tom Warshauer is taking a break from racing to recover from stent surgery.

On a personal note, a few of our lady racers (**Mary Howard, Sandra Lochridge, and I**) were invited to participate in the **21st Linda Elias Memorial Women's One Design regatta**, hosted annually at the Long Beach Yacht Club by the **LB/LA Women's Sailing Association**. The race utilizes the Congressional Cup boats, a fleet of Catalina 37's, which were donated by Frank Butler, founder and president of Catalina Yachts, to LBYC in 1991. Only 11 of the boats were ever built and all are in Long Beach (although a fleet of sister-ship Capri 37's are based in Puerto Vallarta). The boats are maintained through the Long Beach Yacht Club Sailing Foundation and made available for charter, team-building exercises, and Wednesday night races, as well as youth, adult, and women-only beginner through advanced day sails. The women-only events are coached by **SeaGals** volunteers approximately 10 times per year.

The boats are identical, and no adjustments, additions, or subtractions to the rigging are allowed. The only difference between boats is the crew. **Mary and I raced on hull #7 with the SeaGals** while **Sandra filled in on hull #4 with Team Pilikia**. After the first four races, our team was in 3<sup>rd</sup> place, but we lost our position the second day and finished 5<sup>th</sup> among 8 boats after a total of 7 races; Pilikia finished in 7<sup>th</sup> place. It was great fun and required a lot of teamwork to compete against the high-caliber women racers!

The holidays are right around the corner and **CIYC's Parade of Lights committee** has started work on our entry. The theme is "**Holiday in Toyland**". Our design was created by Dann Daggett and Cindy Crocket, who have had numerous winning Parade of Lights entries in years past, before joining CIYC. We can use lots of help to build, paint, and decorate the set, as well as set up the lights and sound and dress up in costume and take part in the animation during the parade. **Planned workdays are every Saturday and Sunday morning (9:00-2:00 or later) until December 8** and some weekday mornings, to be announced. ## WSB Update:

On October 22<sup>nd</sup> under the light of a beautiful half-moon with an outbound high tide ebbing, we released 9,000-plus lively young White Sea Bass. Don Dickey did a tremendous job heading up this year's White Sea Bass project: He had the idea of protecting the fish from predators through the use of orange plastic construction fencing wrapped in multiple layers around the pens. He and his two sons spent many hours in the water doing the hard work of installing the protective barrier.

Both Don and his son Matt dove into the murky water at the release to bring up some dead fish and a dead cormorant from the bottom of the nets. The stench was horrible! Sea Hares, scallops, crabs and smelt were among the fellow residents of the pens. The nets also support tremendous amounts of seaweed and algae and will need thorough cleaning.

Those working at the event were: Don and Matt Dickey, Bob Deyling, Frank Sullivan, Gary Johnson, Zoran Barbaric, Manny and Patrick Vega. Those who were attending, admiring, and lending moral support (and beauty): Cecily, Silvia, Joyce, Amy, Kate, and Erika.

Fortunately, there was no barking of sea lions in the harbor, so we hope our beautiful little White Sea Bass were able to run the gauntlet successfully and make their way into the great ocean.

Thanks go to all the members of the White Sea Bass project who faithfully fed the fish and cleaned the nets every week since the start of the project in spring.

The White Sea Bass enhancement program for 2012 has ended. We started with a total of 14,000 fish in the spring. With the efforts of our crew, we managed to release, six months later, a little more than 9000, 6 to 9 inch White Sea Bass.

My many thanks to all of my fish feeding and volunteers who have spent at least one day a week for the last six months feeding and caring for the fish population.

Over the winter ahead we will be repairing and replacing the roof on the fish pens as well as our angler fund-raising dinner which is coming up to raise money to replace our predator and interior nets.

We are looking forward to spring of 2013 where we will be raising another brood of White Sea Bass with the Hubbs Sea World White Sea Bass in enhancement program.
