Anglers' Corner

Well the New Year is in progress and the Anglers' dues are coming in. I'm still hoping for some input from the members on changes or improvements to the anglers' program. Please drop me a note with your ideas. I know we will have a stellar year.

The recreational fishery for rockfish is closed to boat-based anglers from January 1 through February 28, 2011, re-opening on March 1, 2011. The same is true for Sheephead and Ocean Whitefish. The recreational fishery for Lingcod is closed in all waters, at all depths and to all methods of take through March 31, 2011. Winter Calico Bass fishing however, can be good if you can adjust your technique to the cold-water conditions. One method I was taught by a fishing friend, Cory Visser, he called the web technique. I believe the well-known local Charter Captain, Larry "Calico Hunter" Heron, originated it.

The system requires the use of 2 light line outfits with 8-12lb line. Using lead head plastic lures such as big hammer or similar brand, doctored up with 'Calico Sauce', a lure sent. The key is to cast out the lure into an area outside a kelp line or hard bottom let it sink to the bottom then, leaving the reel in free spool or very light drag to avoid overruns, you put that rod in a rod holder. Then, pick up the other rod, cast it out, and do the same thing. Return to the first rod and begin a medium-slow retrieve for about 5-10 cranks if no bite, drop down do it again vary the number of cranks until you get in the strike zone. What happens is the lure at first darts up off the floor of the ocean. When a nearby Calico or Sand Bass sees it, it will often generate a reflex strike. We tried this technique one late winter day off of Deep Hole for some very nice Calicos and Sand bass.

But don't give up on fishing for the winter make sure you got your new License and give it a try, heck you might even win the monthly \$50 big fish prize! BTW you need to get your dues in if you want to claim a monthly prize.

The juvenile White Sea Bass are growing rapidly and we have had few mortalities. Thank you to all the WSB Team for all your hard work


NEW WEBSITE FOR VENTURA AND CHANNEL ISLANDS RACING SAILORS
