



Local area trivia

It's funny how names of places get changed! Many of us have fished the area south of Pt. Mugu, and know it as Deep Hole. If you have fished it, then you know it is a pile of rocks that comes up from the ocean floor to about 60 feet; there is no hole there.

A friend researched it about 20 years ago and what the "Deep Hole" is, is no more than a misunderstanding of the word "Depot". The way to find that pile of rocks before GPS was to go down the coast until you were off the "Depot", a big tank on the shore and it's still there today. So over the years "Depot" became "Deep Hole."

That tank was the source of water for a restaurant that was on Hwy 1, and was called Bass Rock Cafe. The Ventura County Health Dept. got it shut down in the early 70's, and it was soon demolished after the closure
