Here we are – **another New Year**. OH! Where does the time go?????



### Anglers' Corner Frank Sullivan

Angler's dues of \$10 for the 2010 fishing season are now due. Please send in your dues with your regular club dues billing. If you forgot and sent it in with out the anglers' dues you can provide a SEPARATE check made out to Channel Islands Yacht Club and put Anglers Club in the memo section of the check and send it to the Club or give it to Brandy at the reception counter.

We intend for this to be an exciting and fun filled year. If you are a current member you know the drill but for those of you who are new and may want to join in the fun here are the details:

For only ten bucks you will have a distinctive looking fish next to your name in the CIYC roster; participate in the Club's Tournaments, be eligible for the \$50 Big Fish of the Month Award, as well as the \$100 Big Fish of the Year Award.

Many months go-by when no, or few fish are weighed in which means that the ¼ lb mackerel may be worth \$50, so weigh him in! An Angler can only win once a year so we should have 12 different winners.

Anglers Club funds have, in the past been used for projects around the Yacht Club and for the betterment of our fishing experience, and to support the White Seabass grow out pens in the harbor.

Last year the Anglers donated \$1500 towards the Dining Room folding doors and purchased new wireless microphones.

This year I am soliciting ideas from the members on how to improve the services of the Anglers Club. We will again have an In-Harbor fishing tournament, Ladies Fishing Tournament and Men's Fishing Tournament. Please enclose a note indicating your interest or any other ideas to benefit the welfare of the Club.

If you wish to join this elite group please respond by January 30<sup>th</sup> so we can put the fish logo by your name in the CIYC Roster.

### WSB grow out pen update:

Some time in March we should get this year's first batch of juvenile White Sea Bass for the pens. When we get them they are usually only about 3 to 4inches long. When released the fish are often 7 to 12 inches long. The purpose of this program is to replenish the ocean stock. Once released it takes 4 to 5 years for the fish to reach the legal take limit of 28 inches. Each fish has a hidden coded wire tag imbedded in its right gill plate. The tag is detected by a magnetic sensing device when the heads are turn in to collection stations.

The guys from Hubbs-Sea World, Institute said they are having a hard time getting folks to turn in the WSB heads from their catches especially from the charters, so please insist that the deckies lop of their heads and turn them in for the Hubbs research. We need the information we gain from these returns.

Although the hatchery supplies the 11 grow-out pens from Channel Islands Harbor to San Diego with fish, food, nets, and technical assistance, the labor is provided by volunteers. Labor consists of unloading fish when delivered. Filling the feeders (about every 2 days), scooping out the dead fish and checking for disease, recording mortality, checking the bird net and predator net, maintaining the pens, and releasing the fish under the direction of the hatchery coordinator.

Currently all the volunteers that handle the Channel Islands Harbor grow-out pens are members of the Channel Islands Yacht Club, Anglers.

Turn in your Big (or not so big) fish for the Big Fish of the Month contest & \$50.00.

### "Big Fish of the Month"

\$50 prize is awarded at the end of every month...however; you can only win once per year. Legal fin fish only and no sharks.

### "Big Fish of the Year"

At the end of the year there will be a Big Fish of the Year award for \$100.00. it does not have to be one of the monthly winners, it can be a tourney fish or not, so if you win one month don't quit, the next fish you catch may be worth \$\$\$\$

### HISTORIAN THE CIYC BURGEE

A burgee is a small nautical flag or pennant used to identify a vessel, its owner and/or an organization. One of the rights granted to our membership is the right to fly the Channel Islands Yacht Club burgee.. Our burgee has a triangular shape with a yellow background with three interlocking pyramids representing the three closest Channel Islands, Anacapa, Santa Cruz and Santa Rosa.

When CIYC was still meeting in member's living rooms in 1960, it was decided that our yacht club needed a burgee, so, a contest was opened for the best design. The design adopted was drawn by **Greg Beisel**, son of member **Dena Beisel**, who won a \$25 prize. The original color was gold and black, but our Hong Kong sources can not offer gold, so it now has a yellow background. I have a gold burgee from 1977 flying on my waterside deck made of marine canvas. Only a few were sold in 1977 because they cost \$5 as opposed to \$3 for the Hong Kong variety.

Our burgee is the "brand or trademark" of CIYC: it is on our pocket patch, stationery, and in everything to do with our yacht club. Our burgee has been exchanged with many yacht clubs in the USA as well as overseas.

**Power boats** are to fly the burgee at the bow from a short staff. **Sailboats** are to fly the burgee from the starboard halyard. This identifies the boat and its owner/member with Channel Islands Yacht Club.

Display your burgee and wear your pocket patch proudly as a member of the Channel Islands Yacht Club.


