

I know I said last month that was my last article. However here I am again. Our wonderful Editor would not let me go. I wanted to see if you were paying attention.







Anglers' Corner

White Sea Bass Pen update:

The juvenile fish delivered last month are doing very well after a small die off earlier this month. Thank you to all who helped with preparing the pens, taking delivery, and doing the everyday monitoring of the pens

Fishing report:

I was talking with Hilal Helweh one of the WSB Team members on **Sunday 11-14-10** and he mentioned that he would like to go out after the **Yellowtail** at **Anacapa** again. I said I thought the bite was over, but perhaps I would take the **Valkyrie** out and give it a shot. He said he would be glad to go if he could get away. He mentioned that Ryan Gamble (Gambler), his boat partner, might want to go too.

So I made some calls and soon had a crew; Ryan Gamble, Dick Olsen, Skip Preston, Don Dickey and I. Hilal couldn't get away. All of us except Ryan had worked on the White Sea Bass pens.

Sunday afternoon, Hilal and I took the Valkyrie over to CI Sportfishing and baited up with a scoop of Squid so we could get an early start. At 3am Monday the crew arrived at my house and we were under way by 3:20am. The crossing was flat calm and pitch black, thank God for radar.



We set up near **Fish Camp** before day break and before the high tide. We soon had a few hook ups, one a Bat Ray released, the others broke off on 50lb spectra line with 40lb floral carbon leaders!!

The bite was spotty and well-spaced. Soon the washing machine started, we had a south swell, mixed with a west swell and wind generated waves. Not pleasant and some of the smaller boats around us were rocking and rolling.

A DFG warden came by and said he knew of only 3 yellowtail landed that morning so far. Many of the boats left and we decided that we would make a move and try to be set up before the next tide change. I had a spot I hadn't used for a few years but it use to produce some epic yellowtail action.

We were soon reset and in an area of less swell but more wind. We were tempted to head home but I suggested we give it a hour then decide. Within the first 20 minutes Dick Olsen had broken off one yellowtail and then landed another one, a husky 33.8lb yellowtail.



The rest of us also all had at least a zip and off. Skip Preston had a good fight that lasted at least 15 minutes before it broke off.



Then Don Dickey was hooked up but sawed off when he was fouled with my line while I was trying to clear the lines. Don's next hookup resulted in him landing a very respectable 21.4 lb yellowtail.



The bite slowed and we decided to head in. The crossing was real sloppy with an East Wind and spray coming up over the Flybridge. We are used to those conditions going out not coming in, we usually have a following sea to bring us home. We stopped by the Channel Islands Y.C. to get an official weigh-in. **Dick Olsen's yellowtail is the Big fish of the year for CIYC Anglers** and wins the \$100 prize and his name on the trophy.



So far the big fish of the month of November is Don Dickey's 21.4 lb yellowtail. Dick's doesn't count for the monthly because he previously won in July with a 30lb White Sea Bass.

"Big Fish of the Month"
\$50 prize
 is awarded at the end of every month...however, you can only win once per year. Legal fin fish only and no sharks.

"Big Fish of the Year"
 At the end of the year there will be a Big Fish of the Year award for \$100.00. it does not have to be one of the monthly winners, it can be a tourney fish or not, so if you win one month don't quit, the next fish you catch may be worth \$\$\$\$




