Message From Channel Islanders First Mate Daphne Hetherington

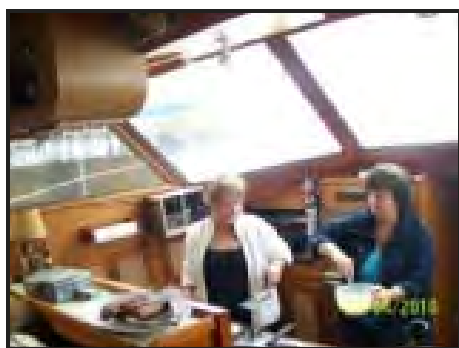
Greetings,

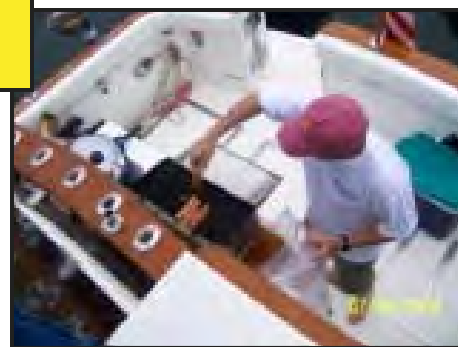

Why does Channel Islands Yacht Club do things the way we do ? A look at our yacht club history will give us some of the answers.

In 1983 and before, the nominating committee selected candidates for Rear Commodore from the "on the water" group of members. The Rear Commodore in 1983 was **P/C Chris Mc Pherson**. An avid sailor on his boat "**All That Jazz**", Chris brought a renewed life to boating activities at CIYC. He did such an outstanding job that when he was elected Vice Commodore in 1984, the "on the water" assignment stayed in his realm, and the next Rear Commodore, **P/C Joe Di Bernardo**, was assigned club house and social duties. And these assigned duties have remained the same since then.

Each year's Commodore, their bridge and directors bring to the club not only their talents, but their interests, for events and socials. In 1993, **P/C John Ricker**, who lived in Santa Maria, organized a true Santa Maria weekend with a SM barbecue and rodeo. Members, about 40, journeyed to Santa Maria, stayed in the same motel where we partied and had an authentic Santa Maria barbecue on the lawn featuring prime local Harris Ranch prime tri tip. This followed an afternoon at the rodeo with CIYC sitting in a reserved section. The rodeo was very patriotic with its pageantry, bronco riding, bull riding, barrel racing, with a finale of mutton busting. The boys and girls (age 4 to 6) were cute and took this very seriously, all dressed up in full western attire, and did a great job riding the sheep until they fell off.

One year we traveled to **Hollywood Park** for horse racing and had clubhouse reserved seats. This year a group traveled to **Santa Anita** for the races. While "Frenchy" was still living at Frenchy's Cove at Anacapa we had a beach picnic and volleyball contest there, and we met the legendary hermit and played with almost all of his cats. He joined us at our picnic. Another year, we had an overnight cruised to **Prisoner's Harbor** on Santa Cruz, where **Louise Mc Pherson** (Chris' wife) , a teacher and knowledgeable geologist, showed us the fossilized plants and animals imprinted in the layered limestone cliff along the beach.

Each year's leaders, the Commodore, their bridge and directors have made each year special by bringing to us at CIYC their talents and interests . **Such is CIYC history.**

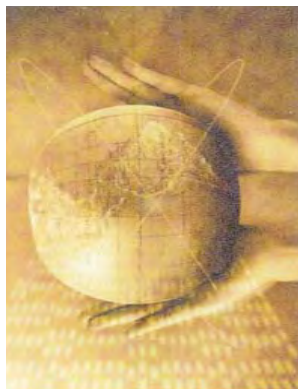

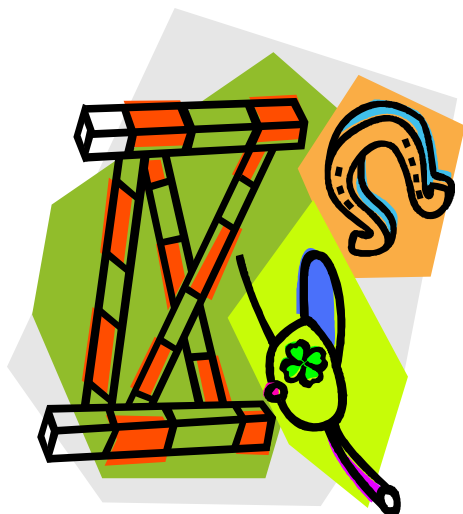

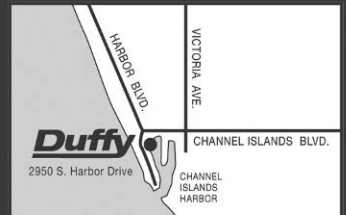
